Autumn Fair - Feedback:

- No need for a disco next year.
- Slushy stall was a great hit so need to think about possibly charging them more next time.
- We had too many cakes, but then ran out of chocolate for the tombola. So suggest we welcome 'homemade' cakes OR chocolate from those allocated year groups.

- Too many mince pies and biscuits more popular than shortbread so need to revise this next year.
- 3 crafters per room worked well, however will ask for deposit to reserve space, as we did have some no shows.
- Not enough volunteers. Going forward, we will put a sign up to say that if no volunteer to take over for the 2nd hour, that stall will have to close. It is important that people get to spend time with their families at these events so they need to be relieved after the hour.
- Having the games in the hall worked well
- Feedback from Pamela all went very smoothly. 2 entry doors was good. We just need more signage at the entrance. Games cards separate from entrance was great.
- Discussed investing in white/flip boards which need to be moveable for signage. Kirsty to speak with a contact about options.

Money raised/spent

- Pamela discussed how current school budget is used to cover essential costs ie staffing, heating, stationery etc. For anything over and above, need to look at were savings can be made. Income generated from the PTA is so important for the children.
- Last year £10k was raised by the PTA which went towards new chairs for the ICT suite, a blue screen, a smart TV and the accelerated reader programme.
- This year, we looking to replace the roof on the gazebo (£6k), plus replace reading material for P1-4, along with some other repairs to outdoor furniture (including a new chalk board for P1/2). Pamela will pull together a pic collage to send out to parents [already done].
- The PTA would also like to look into possibilities of funding something seperately for the children and possible ideas are cycling proficiency or first aid for kids.
- We discussed the success of the recent community day, which as it was using 'volunteers' was allowed and was extremely beneficial for the school.
- We talked about the use of Social Media to make parents aware of necessary repairs so that volunteers can assist. Pamela confirmed that the school website is currently being reviewed to include a newsfeed and possibly connect to Twitter.
- £5k to be given to school now Julia to organise a cheque.

- We need to look into printing a brochure for the night, which will detail all sponsorships (suggesting £50-£100). Options for printing are Stewart Digital or Davenports.

 and enjoy them, rather than volunteer to help out, which is the main problem we
 currently have.
- Year group nights are continuing and these are just for parent to get to know each other. Not organised by PTA committee, needs to be instigated by parent but PTA will support.
